WHY measure nursing workload

Because:

- 1. The number of FTE's (available/required) is related to
 - Effective planning of staffing
 - Costing/Budgeting the ICU (cost nursing staff = 30% total ICU costs)
- 2. It helps to stratify patient populations
- 3. It defines Levels of Care based on P/N ratios

Of all instruments for measuring nursing workload in the ICU

NAS is the best performer

Because:


- The items cover almost all nursing activities
- The description of the items will easily accommodate new activities
- It explains 81% of Total Nursing Time

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
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Modern Nursing Care shall focus on

Capacity, not Competence

Matching Resources



Understanding the use of NAS

Concerns the activities of care performed
Does not cover any Patient/Nurse interaction

Therefore...

NAS is a tool for strictly planning/auditing nursing capacity in the ICU
